FIELD RULES

HOME TEAM is listed first. They occupy the 1st base dugout.

HOME TEAM of 1st game sets up the field and drags the field for 2nd game

HOME TEAM of 2nd game may need to secure the field after games

VISITING TEAM of 2nd game provides Score Keeper and Score Board for 1st game

VISITING TEAM of 1st game provides Score Keeper and Score Board for 2nd game

LEAGUE RULES

4 runs max per inning with the last inning as open/unlimited runs.

Sixty minute (60) timeclock. When time runs out, the current inning will be finished plus one more.

Last inning is the open inning.

Batter starts with a "1 ball" and "1 strike" count, and "1" to waste.

MERCY RULE: if either team is ahead by 12 runs after 5 innings or 10 runs after 6 innings, the game is over.

FLIP RULE: If Visiting Team is ahead by 5 + runs after the 6th inning, the Visiting Team will "flip" and remain in the outfield while the Home Team remains at bat. If the Home Team ties or goes ahead, the Visiting team will have their last at bats.

When a wofield while the HOME TEAM remains at bat

No outfielder or the Rover may throw a woman out at first base.

A male batter who receives a base on balls will be awarded 2 bases IF the following batter is female.

The female batter has the option to hit or take the walk to 1st base.
