FIELD RULES:

HOME TEAM is listed first. They occupy the 1st base dugout.

HOME TEAM of 1st game opens and sets up the field.

HOME TEAM of 2nd game drags the field for their game.

HOME TEAM of 3rd game drags the field for their game.

Whoever IS NOT playing a double header in 2nd game, has Crow's Nest duty for 1st game.

Whoever IS NOT playing a double header in 1st game, has Crow's Nest duty for 2nd game.

Whoever Is playing double header in 1st and 2nd game, has Crow's Nest duty for 3rd game.

Home & Visitor of 3rd game sweep batter's box and on deck circles, drag the field, remove sun shades and place them in storage.

LEAGUE RULES

4 runs max per inning plus last inning as an open/unlimited inning.

There will be a 60 minute CLOCK.

When time runs out, finish current inning plus one more, last inning is the open inning.

Batter starts with "1" and "1" count with "1" to waste.

MERCY RULE - If either team is ahead by 12 after 5 innings or by 10 after 6 innings, the game is OVER.

FLIP RULE - If VISITING TEAM is ahead by 5+ runs after 6th inning, the VISITING TEAM will flip and remain in the

field while the HOME TEAM remains at bat.

If the HOME TEAM ties or scores ahead, VISITING TEAM will have their last ups.

Lineup will not bat more than 2 men in a row and no more than 1 woman batting in a row.

Men's 2s will bat with aluminum bats.

Men's 2s batted ball hitting the fence in the air will be an out.

Men's 2s will play defensively in the outfield (exception of the pitcher).

The Rover is an infield position that no 2 players should play.

Women will be pitched an 11 inch ball, Men will be pitched a 12 inch ball.

When a woman bats, infielders will remain in their <u>normal defensive positions</u> and all outfielders (including the rover)

shall remain outside the 130' arc painted in the outfield and cannot encroach on the batter till the ball has been hit.

The base of the sideline fences are also painted with the 130 foot' arc.

If a player encroaches on the 130' line and plays the ball, the ball is considered dead, the batter is awarded first base and any players on base are awarded the next base.

No outfielder can throw a woman batter out at 1st base.

A male batter who receives a base-on-balls, whether intentional or unintentional, will be awarded

two (2) bases if the following batter is a female.

The following female batter has the option of batting or accepting a walk.

There will be NO running through the bases. Sliding is allowed. There will be NO infield fly rule.

Courtesy runners are limited to once per inning and 3 times per game.

SUBSTITUTES:

All teams will need to maintain at least 4 WOMEN on their team lineup and in the field.

Men's 2 rating can only sub for any 2

Men's 5 rating can only sub for any 5 or 2

Men's 8 rating can sub for any 2, 5, or 8

Any Woman can sub for any Woman
