VISITING TEAM of 1st game provides Score Board operator for 2nd game

HOME TEAM of 2nd game secures the field.

65 league keyfob holder will arm buildings, after games

65 foot base distance

LEAGUE RULES

4 runs max per inning plus last inning as an open/unlimited inning.

Female 5 & 8 rated players can use tournament bats.

2 rated players must use aluminium bat

Pinch runners - any player; limit one time per inning, no limit per game

Batter starts with "1" and "1" count with "1" to waste.

MERCY RULE - If either team is ahead by 12 after 5 innings or by 10 after 6 innings, the game is OVER.

FLIP RULE - If VISITING TEAM is ahead by 5+ runs after 6th inning, the VISITING TEAM will flip and remain in the field If the HOME TEAM ties or scores ahead, VISITING TEAM will have their last ups.
