FIELD RULES:

HOME TEAM is listed first. They occupy the 1st base dugout.

First 2 teams of the day will open the field.

First 2 teams of the day will provide scorekeeper and scoreboard operator for 2nd game.

Second 2 teams will provide scorekeeper and scoreboard operator for first game.

Second 2 teams will brush and close down the field.

LEAGUE RULES:

4 runs max per inning plus last inning as an open/unlimited inning.

No Clock will be used.

When time runs out, finish current inning plus one more, last inning is the open inning.

65 foot bases will be used. There will be NO infield fly rule.

There will be NO running through the bases. Sliding is allowed.

Batter starts with "1" and "1" count with "1" to waste.

MERCY RULE - If either team is ahead by 12 after 5 innings or by 10 after 6 innings, the game is OVER.

FLIP RULE - If VISITING TEAM is ahead by 5+ runs after 6th inning, the VISITING TEAM will flip and remain in the field while the HOME TEAM remains at bat.

If the HOME TEAM ties or scores ahead, VISITING TEAM will have their last ups.

Lineup will not bat more than 2 men in a row and no more than 1 woman batting in a row.

All teams will need to maintain 4/5 women up to bat and in the field.

No tournament bats for either men or women will be used.

American League Men will bat with aluminum bats.

American League Men will play defensively in the outfield (exception of the pitcher).

The Rover is an infield position that no American League (1,2,3) rated players should play.

Women will be pitched an 11 inch ball, Men will be pitched a 12 inch ball.

When a woman bats, infielders will remain in their normal defensive positions and all outfielders (and the rover).

shall remain outside the 130' arc painted in the outfield and cannot encroach on the batter till the ball has been hit.

The base of the sideline fences are also painted with the 130 foot' arc.

If a player encroaches on the 130' line, the ball is considered dead, the batter is awarded first base and any players on base are awarded the next base.

No outfielder (nor the Rover) can throw a woman batter out at 1st base.

A male batter who receives a base-on-balls, whether intentional or unintentional, will be awarded two (2) bases if the following batter is a female.

The following female batter has the option of batting or accepting a walk.

Courtesy runners are limited to once per inning and 3 times per game.

SUBSTITUTES:

A male rated player can only sub for the same rated player or a player with a smaller number.

For example: a male 3 rated player can sub for a 1, 2, or 3 rated player.

Any Woman can sub for any Woman

Managers are to utilize the Substitute list 1st and then other team players.
